### **GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Assists in designing and then creates, builds, shapes, and maintains and repairs unique wooden and/or plastic devices to assist students with physical disabilities to become more independent; performs related duties as required.

- 3. Confers with occupational and physical therapists, teachers, and consultant bioengineer to design appropriate devices.
- 4. Repairs and alters these devices, as required.
- 5. Keeps tools, equipment, and work area clean and in good condition.
