CLASS SPECIFICATION

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GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Assists in developing audio-visual aids for instructional purposes and in providing advisory services relating to their development and use; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under direct supervision, the duties of this position require creativity and technical knowledge.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- 1. Assists in designing and developing visual aids such as maps, charts, graphs, transparencies, etc.
- 2. Tapes radio broadcasts and television programs for presentation during school hours.
- 3. Receives training in providing advisory services to teachers regarding development and use of audio-visual aids.
- 4. Receives training in television production.
- 5. Records student special activities.
- 6. Maintains circulation records for A. V. equipment.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- 1. Knowledge of the operation of projection, sound, and recording equipment.
- 2. Knowledge of procedures and techniques involved in the manufacture of visual aids, such as transparencies, charts, and graphs.
- 3. Ability to design and develop visual aids.
- 4. Ability to assist in planning and/or making presentations.
