GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Assists in the maintenance and repair of a variety of electronic equipment; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, the duties involve the exercise of judgment in assisting in the testing and servicing of electronic equipment.

TYPICAL DUTIES

1. Assists in repairing and replacing components on a variety of electronic equipment, including television equipment and microcomputers.
2. Assists in the operation and maintenance of a variety of electronic devices including scientific, transmitting, and receiving equipment.
3. Keeps tools and working area in good condition.
4. Picks up and delivers equipment, as required.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

1. Knowledge of the maintenance and repair of a variety of electronic equipment and their applications, including microcomputers.
2. Knowledge of the materials, tools, and equipment used in the repair and maintenance of electronic equipment.
3. Knowledge of the use of electronic test equipment.
4. Ability to follow oral and written instructions.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Training and Experience

Graduation from high school

and

Completion of a two-year course in electronic technology.

Necessary Special Requirement

Continuing possession of an appropriate class, valid Driver license issued by the State of New York, if required.
