## **GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Assists in administering the school lunch program in a large school district; performs related duties as required.

#### **COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES**

Under direct supervision, this is an important supervisory position in relieving the school lunch manager of the heavy amount of detail work in administering a school lunch program. Employees in this class participate in all areas of administration and act as liaison between schools and school lunch manager.

#### **TYPICAL DUTIES**

- 1. Assists in the supervision of all food service personnel in the district.
- 2. Acts as liaison between school and school lunch manager.
- 3. Assists in planning menus, purchase of food and equipment.
- 4. Assists in preparation of budget, state reports and other clerical work.
- 5. Relieves in kitchen in absence of cook-manager, cashier, etc.
- 6. Visits schools in district to check on maintenance of standards and uniformity of procedures.

### FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- 1. Knowledge of the fundamentals of nutrition and their application to a school lunch program.
- 2. Knowledge of the principles and practices of large quantity food preparation.
- 3. Ability to supervise the work of others.
- 4. Ability to keep records and aid in submitting reports.
