**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Performs technical work in testing students for hearing defects; performs related duties as required.

**COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES**

Under general supervision, the position requires the use of judgment in applying relevant methods, procedures, and agency policy to audiometric testing.

**TYPICAL DUTIES**

- \* 1. Confers with physicians, teachers, school nurses, and parents relating to preparing for audiometric tests.
- \* 2. Sets up audiometer, examines it prior to testing, and maintains equipment in working order.
- \* 3. Administers audiological tests to monitor status of hearing impaired students.
- \* 4. Confers with parents, teachers, nurses, and physicians regarding results of tests, and to disseminate information about the program.
- \* 5. Plans and conducts training conferences for staff members.
- \* 6. Participates in evaluation of students with multiple health problems.
- 7. Recommends purchase of new equipment, as required.
