## **GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Plans, coordinates, and evalutes a specialized educational enrichment program; performs related duties as required.

#### **COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES**

Under general supervision, the duties require independent judgment in planning programs, organizing and directing volunteers, and coordinating and implementing teachers' recommendations in line with available resources and budgetary constraints; may supervise clerical staff.

## **TYPICAL DUTIES**

- 1. Plans, under the guidance of the teaching staff, a program that supplements specific curriculum.
- 2. Recruits guest speakers, establishes workshops and demonstrations, and secures educational films.
- 3. Observes and evaluates speakers, demonstrations, and films.
- 4. Recruits and supervises student volunteers working in the program.
- 5. Prepares notifications to participants, attendance lists, and reports.
- 6. Coordinates the clerical and para-professional staff assigned to the program.

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- 1. Knowledge of instructional techniques, materials, and resources.
- 2. Ability to observe and evaluate program material, ie. speakers, films, workshops, and demonstrations.
- 3. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students and teaching staff.
- 4. Ability to keep records and make reports.

# **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

#### **Training and Experience**

- Associates degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college with course work in Education; or
- 2. Completion of two years of training with full credit at a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with course work in Education.
- **NOTE:** Experience in a paid, full-time position responsible for planning and implementing an organized educational or cultural program for school age children may be substituted for the educational requirement above on a year-for-year basis up to a maximum of two years.

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
