**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Repairs and maintains precision electronic equipment; performs related duties as required.

**COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES**

Under general supervision, The duties involve the exercise of judgment in testing and servicing electronic equipment.

**TYPICAL DUTIES**

1. Repairs, maintains and tests electronic equipment, including audio-visual equipment and microcomputers.
2. Reads and interprets schematics and complex wiring diagrams.
3. Performs testing evaluation and trouble shooting of equipment.
4. Assists in the construction and modification of precision instruments and equipment.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES**

1. Considerable knowledge of the maintenance and repair of a variety of electronic equipment and its applications, including microcomputers.
2. Knowledge of procedures, practices, materials, tools and equipment used in the repair and maintenance of electronic equipment.
3. Knowledge of the use of electronic test equipment.
4. Ability to maintain accurate records and prepare reports.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

**Training and Experience**

Graduation from high school

and

Completion of a two-year course in electronic technology

and

Two years of satisfactory experience servicing and testing electronic equipment.

**NOTE:** Satisfactory experience, as outlined above, in excess of the two-year requirement may be substituted for the course in electronic technology and/or high school education on a year-for-year basis up to a maximum of four years.
