Participates in the design and layout of art work for the production of a variety of graphic materials; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, the incumbent designs, plans and produces art work. Assignments are received in a form of detailed instructions, and the procedures and techniques to be used are predetermined.

- 5. Letters covers for reports, brochures and leaflets.
- 6. Prepares and installs or mounts exhibits and displays.
