GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Installs, maintains and repairs electrical systems equipment and fixtures; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under direct supervision, the position requires use of judgment and skill and the work is reviewed for quality, accuracy and completeness.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- 1. Makes repairs to electrical motors, fire alarm systems, lights, power circuits, appliances, generators and a variety of other electrical equipment.
- 2. Troubleshoots, locates and corrects power failures and short circuits.

- 4. Makes emergency repairs to elevators, generators and other electrical apparatus.

- 6. Makes work time estimates and keeps simple records.
- 7. Performs a variety of non-electrical maintenance and repair tasks as required.
