GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Operates a motor vehicle or other light automotive equipment in the performance of assigned tasks; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, this class of employee operates an automobile or small truck for the purpose of collecting and delivering messages, records and materials. Instructions are usually received in the form of written or oral requests for specific items to be picked up or delivered. The employee may participate in cleaning or routine clerical tasks.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- * 1. Operates passenger vehicle or light truck in calling for and delivering, supplies, equipment, food stores and other materials.
- * 2. Operates motorized lawn mowing and snow plowing equipment.
- * 3. Performs minor routine maintenance service on vehicles such as checking water, gas, oil, air, and other necessities for vehicles.
 - 4. Performs routine cleaning or clerical tasks between deliveries.
- * 5. Drives a truck to transport laborers, supplies, tools, equipment, office furniture, etc., as required.
