GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Operates cameras to produce still and motion pictures in color and black and white; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, the duties require judgment in selecting subjects or items to be photographed.

TYPICAL DUTIES

1. Operates cameras for still and motion pictures in black and white and color.
2. Develops negatives, prints, enlarges, copies, and performs other finishing and dark room processes.
3. Operates various types of projection equipment.
4. Assists in writing and editing films.
5. Provides assistance in planning publicity or instruction programs using photographic media.
6. Prepares exhibits using photographic materials.
7. Maintains equipment.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

1. Knowledge of the equipment, techniques, and materials used in still and motion pictures in black and white, and color.
2. Knowledge of the preparation of chemicals for developing processes.
3. Skill in the operation of various types of still and motion picture cameras, and the processing of film.
4. Ability to provide routine maintenance to equipment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Training and Experience

Completion of a New York State Education Department approved full-time training program in professional photography of at least six months' duration
and

Two years of satisfactory experience as a professional photographer.
