GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, is responsible for radio announcing of educational, cultural and sporting events; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

An employee in this class is responsible for performing work of moderate difficulty and responsibility in radio announcing within the framework of station broadcasting policies. The work requires the use of discretion and independent judgment in the reporting and announcing of various events.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- 1. Reads prepared continuity and spot announcements.
- 2. Speaks extemporaneously in the event of an emergency.
- 3. Announces sporting events, ceremonies and musical concerts.
- 4. Interviews public officials, celebrities and performing artists.
- 5. Rehearses and checks the order and timing of assigned programs with station personnel and guests.
- 6. Assists in writing continuity, editing and preparation of special material.
- 7. Keeps necessary records and makes required reports.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- 1. Knowledge of techniques, methods and practices of radio announcing.
- 2. Knowledge of good interviewing techniques.
- 3. Knowledge of station broadcasting policies and practices.
