# **GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Coordinates interscholastic athletic programs; performs related duties as required.

## **COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES**

Under general supervision, the duties involve planning and coordinating a variety of interscholastic athletic team programs.

## **TYPICAL DUTIES**

- \* 1. Plans and participates in meetings with secondary school physical education and recreation supervisors concerning the set up and scheduling of athletic contests between schools.
- \* 2. Reviews and evaluates officials' ratings and experience to insure appropriate assignment.
- \* 3. Answers specific questions with regard to rules, regulations, equipment, and officiating related to interscholastic sports.
- \* 4. Maintains liaison with local district athletic departments to resolve problems and complaints.
  - 5. Maintains records and prepares reports, as required.

#### \*ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- 1. Thorough knowledge of the planning and organizing of interscholastic athletic competition.
- 2. Knowledge of recreation administrative theory and practices.
- 3. Knowledge of current trends in school athletics and Physical Education.
- 4. Ability to plan and organize interscholastic athletic competition.
- 5. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with school athletic directors and community agencies.
- 6. Ability to express oneself effectively, both orally and in writing.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

## Training and Experience

Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a major in Physical Education or Recreation and

Two years of satisfactory, paid experience coordinating and/or planning, or assisting in the coordination and/or planning of athletic contests and/or recreation programs.

**NOTE:** 1. Experience, as outlined above, in excess of the two-year requirement, may be substituted for college education on a year-for-year basis.

2. In addition to the two years experience, as outlined above, satisfactory,

paid experience as an athletic official may substitute for college education on a year-for-year basis.
