GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Supervises and participates in guidance and counseling activities in a drug abuse program; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

- 5. Prepares required reports.

- 1. Thorough knowledge of the various aspects of drug abuse problems.
- 2. Considerable knowledge of individual and group counseling techniques.
- 3. Ability to supervise the work of subordinate personnel.
