**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Under direct supervision, performs manual work in the operation and maintenance of steam heating equipment; performs related duties as required.

**COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES**

Employees in this class are responsible for the efficient and economical operation of steam heating equipment. Work may also include the assignment of maintenance repair tasks in and around the boiler and throughout the building of assignment.

**TYPICAL DUTIES**

1. Operates and repairs a heating system including auxiliary equipment.
2. Keeps constant check on boiler operation; receives oil delivery; takes readings and soundings; maintains burner and oil log.
3. Receives and answers all complaints about the heating system.
4. Draws boiler water samples and tests same, adding chemicals if necessary.
5. Makes minor repairs to equipment in building of assignment.
6. May operate and maintain a ventilating system.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES**

1. Knowledge of the operation and maintenance of steam boilers and related equipment.
2. Some knowledge of electrical equipment.
3. Ability to make moderately difficult mechanical repairs.
4. Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
5. Ability to keep records and make reports of activities; dependability.
6. Good physical condition.

**Training and Experience**

1. No formal education requirement.
2. One year of experience as a helper in a boiler room.
