GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Supervises the development of audio-visual aids for instructional purposes and the maintenance and operation of associated equipment; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, this position requires creativity, technical knowledge, and the use of considerable independent judgment.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- 1. Confers with and advises teachers regarding types of visual or audio aids to be used.
- 2. Designs and develops aids such as maps, charts, graphs, etc.
- 3. Develops film strips.
- 4. Records student activities.
- 5. Supervises maintenance and repair of equipment.
- 6. Records and transmits television programs.
- 7. Keeps maintenance records of all repair work performed.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- 1. Extensive knowledge of repair and maintenance of audio-visual equipment.
- 2. Knowledge of the operation of audio-visual equipment.
- 3. Ability to supervise subordinates.
- 4. Ability to keep records.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Training and Experience

- 1. Graduation from high school and
- 2. Completion of two years of technical school involving the operation, maintenance and repair of projection, sound and video equipment and
- 3. Four years of experience in work involving the development and use of audiovisual material.
- **NOTE:** Experience, as outlined above, in excess of the four-year requirement may be substituted for education on a year-for-year basis up to a maximum of four years.
