**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Under direct supervision, is responsible for the safe operation and maintenance of a swimming pool and adjacent areas in a school building; performs related duties as required.

**TYPICAL DUTIES**

1. Operates and maintains machinery used in pumping and purifying swimming pool water.
2. Inspects, tests, overhauls and repairs filters, valves, pumps and all related swimming pool apparatus.
3. Makes regular inspections to insure clean and sanitary condition of pool and premises.
4. Assists in dispensing bathing suits and towels.
5. Requisitions supplies and equipment as needed.
6. Takes water sample, tests same and maintains proper chlorine level.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES**

1. Knowledge of swimming pool management, operation and maintenance.
2. Knowledge of pool safety regulations.
3. Ability to operate, maintain and repair swimming pool machinery and auxiliary equipment.
4. Ability to keep records.
5. Good physical condition.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

**Training and Experience**

Completion of an eighth grade education  
and either

1. Two years of experience as a custodian, general mechanic or steam firer  
or
2. One year of building cleaning experience which included responsibility for the maintenance of a swimming pool.
