#### **GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

### **COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES**

Under general supervision, the duties require the use of judgment in providing technical assistance in the production of programs.

### FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- 1. Knowledge of theory and operation of television studio operations, transmission, techniques, and equipment.
- 2. Knowledge of procedures, practices, materials, tools, and equipment used in television productions.
- 3. Ability to maintain studio, microwave, and distribution equipment.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

#### **Training and Experience**

Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university, including or supplemented by courses in the production of television programs and

Two years of satisfactory experience operating and maintaining a television studio.
