GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Performs technical studio work in the production of television programs; performs related work as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, the duties require the use of judgment in providing technical assistance in the production of programs.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- * 1. Operates and maintains a television studio.
- * 2. Operates and maintains television receiving, recording, transmission, distribution, and viewing equipment.
- 3. Transmits instant replay of commercial broadcasts.
- * 4. Provides technical assistance in production of programs.
- 5. Diagnoses malfunctions and repairs or replaces components.
- * 6. Maintains records and prepares reports on operation and repairs of technical equipment.

***ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

1. Knowledge of theory and operation of television studio operations, transmission, techniques, and equipment.
2. Knowledge of procedures, practices, materials, tools, and equipment used in television productions.
3. Ability to maintain studio, microwave, and distribution equipment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Training and Experience

Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university, including or supplemented by courses in the production of television programs and

Two years of satisfactory experience operating and maintaining a television studio.

1. One year of satisfactory experience, as outlined above, in excess of the two-year requirement, may substitute for courses in television production.
 2. Experience, as outlined above, in excess of the two-year requirement, may be substituted for college education, on a year-for-year basis.
