GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Performs responsible coordinating and liaison work between BOCES and the employment community; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, plans and develops cooperative working relationships with public and private employers and community agencies to increase the career opportunities for vocationally trained students.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- 1. Initiates and assists in developing a County-wide Industry/Education Council.
- 2. Identifies problem areas in the placement of vocationally trained students.
- 3. Sets up work shops seminars and provides similar educational opportunities for vocational education teachers to work with industry representatives.
- 4. Contacts industry leaders and representatives and encourages industry participation in the development of experimental teaching and career guidance programs.
- 5. Selects and disseminates industry/educational material to school district personnel.
- 6. Prepares program and activity reports as required.
